Exercise

Create the itineraries for each problem below. Use *I to display each completed itinerary and the XI to cancel before going to the next problem.

1. Mrs. Eva Smith would like to travel from SLC to JFK next Sunday. She would like a morning flight, Y class. She will be driving from JFK to BOS and wants to return from BOS to SLC on Thursday evening.
2. Miss Barbie Dahl requests you book her a nonstop flight on the 14th of next month from BOS to YYZ in the morning. She will return on the 18th in the evening.
3. Constance Candy and her two friends want to fly from PHX to Hartford, CT. Reserve three Q (or B, or H) seats for them on a morning flight the 19th of next month. They will need open tickets on the 21st in Y class on AA from Hartford to JFK and then they will be taking the commuter train to Washington, D. C. They will need a flight on the 25th in the early afternoon from the Washington area (DCA, IAD, or BWI) back to PHX.
4. Mr. Terrell Buff will be going to Minneapolis from Denver, F class, of course, on the 15th of next month. He prefers to fly around noon. He will be returning on the 21st around 5:00 p.m.

Redisplay the itinerary. Change his return to the 22nd.

5. Mrs. Polly Wog and her son want to fly from Boston to Miami on a flight around 9 a.m. on AA on the 18th of next month. Book them a return flight five days later. They want the discounted Q fare.

Waitlist them on their choice, and then book an alternate class of service.

Redisplay the itinerary. Change the return flight to 1 week later.

6. Mr. Brent Brown needs to travel from Baltimore to Chicago on the 12th of next month. He would like to leave around 10:30 a.m. and likes United. On the 14th he needs to go to Denver, and then to Salt Lake on the 16th, leaving about noon both flights. He will return to Baltimore on the 19th on American Airlines.
